



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Glensborro' situate on the West side of the North East branch of Susquehanna about three miles below the Falls at Nescopeck on the East side of a Creek called Kahawanishoning or Briar Creek. Including the mouth of the Creek in Northampton County containing three hundred acres with the usual allowance of 6 per cent for Roads. Surveyed for Robert Glenn 10th August 1769. In Pursuance of an order N^o 4 Dated the Third day of April 1769
