



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Narrow Bottom Situate on the Southernly Side of the North East Branch of Susq^a River about a mile and a half above the Mouth of Fishing Creek including the Mouth of a Small Run, in the County of Northumberland — Containing Eighty acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of 6 p cent for Roads. Surveyed the 17th Day of September 1772 For John Owen Sen^r. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 12th Day of June 1772.
