



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Situate on the South side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River including the head of two Springs falling into a Run called Willsons or Troy Run about two miles from the mouth and 9 miles from Fort Augusta in Northumberland County containing one hundred and thirty acres and a half besides the usual allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c.

Surveyed the 13th Day of July 1774 for Richard Price in pursuance of a warrant dated the 30th day of March 1774.
