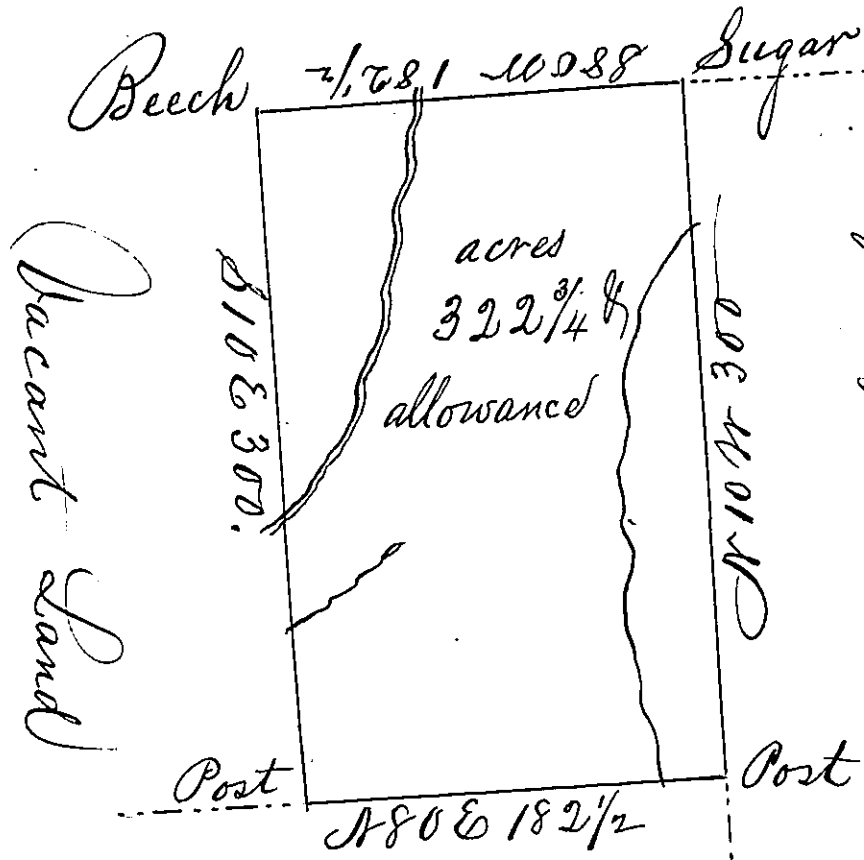


Vacant Land
