



Surveyed on the twenty second day of August 1793 nine hundred and ninety acres of Land with the allowance of six per cent, situate in District No. 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River, adjoining Wilhem Willink and others No. 2870, by virtue of a warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eyken, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpin- ninck of Amsterdam No. 2910, dated the 13th day of December 1792.
