A, containing one hundred & forty six acres & eighty three perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c; Surveyed to George Royer and Jacob Kunkel in pursuance of a warrant dated the 14th June 1785. B, containing two hundred and eighty two acres & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Part of a larger tract of four hundred & eighty two acres, one hundred & fifty seven perches & allowance, Surveyed to Jacob Kunkel & George Royer in pursuance of a warrant dated the 1st of October 1784. Resurveyed & divided the 9th June 1811 for Adam Gevert.
