



The above is a draught of a survey made the 16th day Dec, 1784 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Abraham Hartshorn dated the 13th day of Oct^r 1784, situate on the waters of ten mile creek joining lands of Benjamin Rice and others Washington County called the Winter Green, containing three hundred acres with the usual allowance for highways.
