



By virtue of a warrant dated 17th August 1793, Surveyed
 2nd September 1793 to Jacob Auld the above tract of
 land, Situate in Luzerne County on the branches of a
 small stream that empties on the East side
 of Susquehanna River about two miles and a
 half below the State Line & about one mile
 above Tioga Point containing four hundred and
 thirty three acres and one hundred and fifty
 four perches and allowance of six percent
 for roads &c.
