Stewart ^{Jr.} was surveyed on the 14th day of June 1814 the above described tract of land containing 481 acres 21 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate, in Bloomfield Township Crawford County and at the time of making the same Richard Shrieve was residing there under James Hamilton and there ^{was} built a house for ^{the} habitation of man and a mill house and Carding ^{mill} and there appeared to have been cleared and fenced upwards of ten Acres of the same, and that the same was divided as above stated between said Hamilton and Joseph Clark
