 dated the 11th March 1786 the above Warrant of Rex's was surveyed the 19th Septem^r
 1794 containing 115 1/2 Acres & returned in ^{the} Surveyor General's Office before Moorhead's
 Warrant was delivered to him but that Survey by mistake included part of the
 land surveyed & Patented to William Rex by Warrant of the 1st June 1785
 Therefore I pray the Board of Property to accept this return.
