



Draft of the Resurvey of a tract of Land situated in Lamantownship, Clinton County originally surveyed pursuant to a Warrant dated December 10<sup>th</sup> 1829, Granted to Alexander & Zacharias McNaull in trust &c. And I find one hundred and Eleven acres and one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance of 6 per cents for roads &c Unincumbered by older Warrants and Surveys, to wit: - David Currey Warrant dated December 9<sup>th</sup> 1794, Henry Dounel Warrant dated Feby. 6<sup>th</sup> 1794, Jonathan Cook Warrant dated Sept. 22<sup>d</sup> 1794, David Liggot Warrant dated May 2<sup>d</sup> 1795, Robert Ritchey Warrant dated Feby. 27<sup>th</sup> 1794, all of which is Represented by by dotted lines. And the Ritchey Survey extends South, and interferes with Liggot, thereby covering part of the McNaull marked B. and Cook and Dounel are Represented by C & D. The old McNaull tract is included within the Red Lines and the David Currey within the Yellow lines, Resurvey November 10<sup>th</sup> 1869, for John McNaull and William Harting the present owners of the above property.
