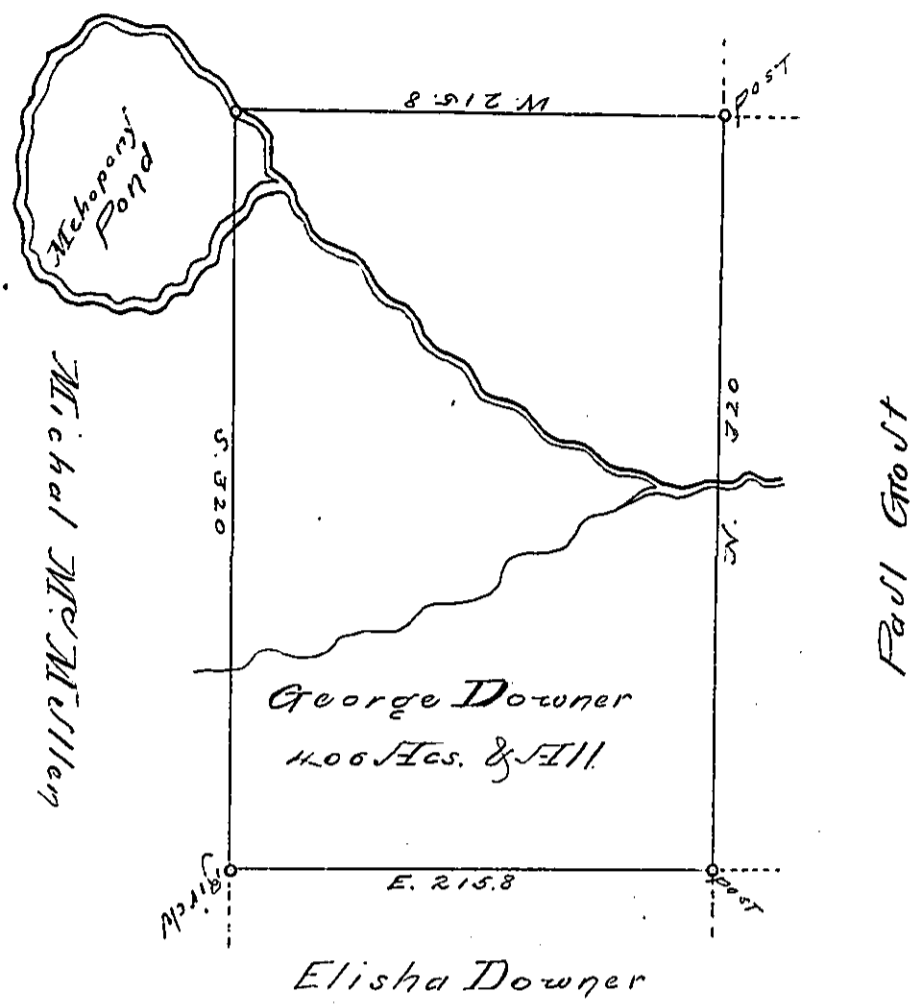


Joseph Scott
