



A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed the 3^d day of June 1793 for Thomas Wallace in Pursuance of his Warrant for 300 Acres Dated the 25 day of July 1792, Situate & lying North and West of the River Ohio, Allegheny and Conowingo Creek about two Miles from the Manor line opposite the Town of Pittsburg, including the three Springs on the Curcuckey Path, the head of the Long run and the Forks of the Road, called Mount Pleasant. Containing three hundred and thirty Acres, with the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads.
