



Situate on the waters of Redstone Creek and Surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1788, at the particular request and Request of the owner the same having been Surveyed to James Craig on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1786 by virtue of a Certificate from the Commissioners for settling claims &c. the Warrant on which this Survey is founded bears date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1776. but for what reason it was so long kept back from execution I know not — Mr. Craig I believe has patented the Land, And the acceptance of this Survey is Submitted to you
