



In pursuance of an Order No. 2180 dated the third of April 1769. Surveyed for Joseph Armstrong the above described tract of land containing three hundred and twelve acres with an allowance proportioned to 6 Per cent, situated on the Kittinging path, adjoining land of Saml. Culberson & Tho. Cahill, now in Westmoreland County Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> of May 1771.
