



Surveyed the above described Island on the 24th day of June 1815, by ^{for} William Deuling in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date 17th day of June 1815 containing sixteen stones & sixty eight perches strick measure ^{situation} near the Middle of the West Branch of the Susquehanna, about twenty one miles above the Great Island immediately below a small Island a tremendous Mountain opposite on the Centre County side and Lands claimed by McGinley & Shaffer on the North in Dumstable Township Lycoming County improved and in possession of Frederick Shaffer
