N. B. By Order of Board of Property of
 6th Sept. 1790 the part described by the Red
 lines Ordered to be surveyed & Ret^d for E.
 Blaine On location of Alex^r Blaine N^o 389 -
 the Judgment & copy of the above lines
 delivered to Col^l Blaine the 5th Oct. 90.

In Obediance to an Order from the Hon^{ble} Board of Property dated March 3rd 1788 in the above case. I have made a Plott of the Surveys mentioned in the s^d Caveat, and also that on which Col. Arch^d Lockrey formerly lived, which contains about 6 7/2 Acres, and have taken the Courses & Distances of the Great Road, from Mr. Todds House to Col. Proctors old House, and laid it down. I also took the course & Distance from Col. Proctors House, to an old House Field and Meadorr, said to be built & cleared by W^m Proctor Sen deceased, on that Tract which W^m Proctor son of John Proctor now lives. I also took the Course & Distance to the Flag run, and took the Course of it & laid it down, and also laid down the 12 Mile run, where it crosses the Great Road, and runs through the several Tracts, and marked down the several Houses, as nigh their situa^{tion} as possible. I have also from Observation, marked down by Dotted lines, where the body of the clear Land, contained on each Tract lies;
