



The above is a draught of a Survey made on the 21st day of January 1842 for John McKee situated in Mifflin Township Allegheny County. Containing Ninety Nine Acres and Eighty one perches & 1/10 and allowance of six per cent. (It being part of an original Survey made December 19th 1816 in pursuance of an Order No. 3549, dated June 23rd 1769 granted to David McKee for 300 A. - Note. The part marked A. contains 25 A. 87.6 ps & allowance and is unpatented. That part marked B. in meet the River is said to be patented on a Penn^a Warrant in the name of Margaret McKee.
