By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries to me directed bearing date the day of Annno Dom. 1734 I have laid out on 1<sup>st</sup> ay of February in the year above said unto George Gray of the Township Kingeeps in the County of Philadelp so large Lots of Ground within 1<sup>st</sup> acts of Philadelphia City; One of wh<sup>ch</sup> is bounded on the South by High Street & extends by the said Street No<sup>th</sup> by five degrees West Six hundred feet to Schuylkil River thence by said River North twenty one degrees East Six hundred sixty two feet thence by berry Street South seventy five degrees East Six hundred feet to Schuylkil From thence by 1<sup>st</sup> Street South fifteen degrees West Six hundred & sixty feet to the place of Beginning containing nine acres & seventy five perches The Lot is bounded on the North by Street & extends by the said Street with Seventy five degrees East from Front Street Six hundred & fifty feet thence by the said Front Street South fifteen degrees West four hundred eighty four feet to Street thence by the 1<sup>st</sup> Street North seventy five degrees West seven h<sup>undred</sup> & ten feet to the 1<sup>st</sup> River thence by the same North twenty one degrees E<sup>ast</sup> four hundred eighty five feet & a half to the place of Beginning Containing acres & eighty nine perches.
