

Started from a Stone East corner between N<sup>o</sup> 273 in the Certified township of Providence, and on the N.W. Bank of Lacawanna Creek.

Thence N. 54. W. a cultivated field of Daniel Taylor containing about 5 acres two perches from my line to Lt 41. x small stream pt Lt 109 x main road leading up Lacawanna 158 Taylor's brush fence about 1/4<sup>th</sup> of an acre partially cleared to Lt 190 x small stream pt Lt 198 x another pt Lt 516 x mill creek pt Lt 520 to Ezer Taylor's improvement his house tenanted by Peter W. Moore. Pt about an acre cleared to Lt 556 x St Johns Brook pt Lt 691.5 the distance for Sarah Delany, no timber, could not find her line, made a pine corner - Memo - Sarah Delany does not come within the provisions of the compromising Act, being surveyed in 1759.

Thence by land surveyed for Sarah Delany S. 42. 45. W. 79 made stake corner

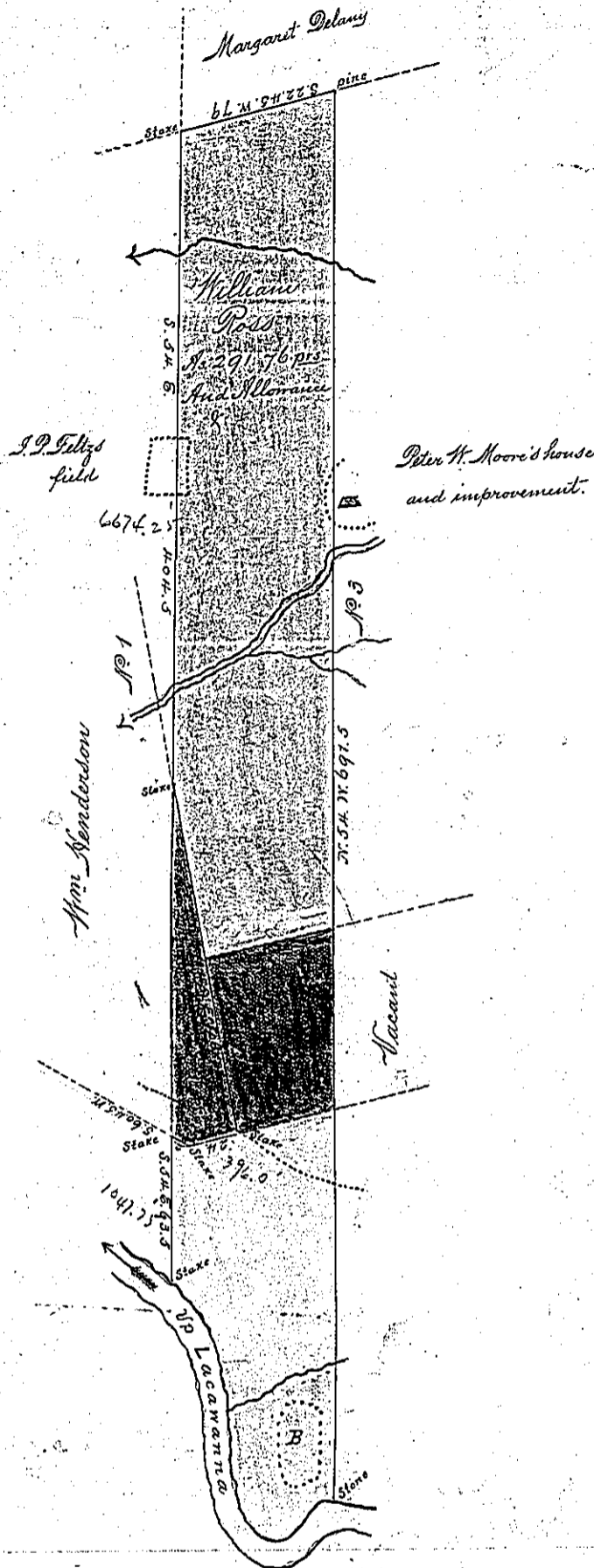
Thence by Lt 1 and including land released (under Act of 4<sup>th</sup> Ap<sup>l</sup> 1799) by Sam<sup>l</sup> Meredith S. 54. E. 25 x St Johns Brook pt Lt 134 to improved land of John P. Feltz about 1/4 of an acre imp<sup>d</sup> to Lt 321 x Mill brook pt Lt 404.5 made a stake corner in N.E. line of land surveyed for W<sup>m</sup> Henderson and not released to Commonwealth. Surveyed in 1759.

Thence by S<sup>t</sup> Hendersons land S. 67. 45. E. including land surveyed by Sam<sup>l</sup> Meredith and released to Comm<sup>ty</sup> 60 p<sup>rs</sup> to vacant land to Lt 62 Spring pt Lt and in improved land of Feltz, about 1/2 acre to Lt 106.7 to land released by James Moore - made a stake by main road.

Thence by S<sup>t</sup> Moore's land, S. 46. 45. W. being also by said Hendersons land not released as afo<sup>sd</sup> 24 to stake, and including about 1/4<sup>th</sup> of an acre of S<sup>t</sup> Feltz's land who has cleared over the line, he living on Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1.

Thence S. 60. 45. W. by said Hendersons land 2 p<sup>rs</sup> to stake in the line between lots N<sup>o</sup> 1 and two

Thence by lot N<sup>o</sup> 1, including land released by Sam<sup>l</sup> Meredith S. 54. E. 63. 5 to Lacawanna and thence up it as per margin

N. B. A. Represents the house and about 120 perches of cleared land occupied by Daniel Taylor who has resided in it since early in February 1818 - B. represents another cleared field of S<sup>t</sup> Taylor containing about four acres, the house has been occupied occasionally, and with intermissions, prior to Taylor's living in it as far as Sean learn since 1806.

The part shaded in yellow represents part of two tracts originally surveyed for and released by Sam<sup>l</sup> Meredith under the provisions of the compromising Act.

The part shaded in Orange represents part of land surveyed for and released by James Moore as afo<sup>sd</sup> for W<sup>m</sup> Henderson, and not within the provisions of the afo<sup>sd</sup> Act being surveyed in 1759, and is not included in this survey.

The part shaded in Blue appears to have been heretofore vacant
