



A draught of a tract of land situate on Mysop Creek near the mouth thereof in the Township of Mysop and County of Luzerne (Now Bradford) containing three hundred and six acres and seventy six perches with allowance of six per cent for roads including the improvements of Ralph Martin and heirs of Theophilus Moger deceased Com. sued the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1785 and continued, consisting of two dwelling houses barns and other buildings, and sixty or more acres of improved land the residence of several families Surveyed to Ralph Martin and heirs of Theophilus Moger the first day of September 1811.
