



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Waycock Township in the County of Bucks containing one hundred Acres one hundred & Six Perches and an Allowance of six per Ct. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1770. fifty 3 Acres whereof was soon after returned to Peter Diel and the remainder to Felix Diel - into the Surveyor Generals Office. On which a Dispute arose between the Executors of the said Peter Diel and the said Felix Diel and having had a hearing before the Secretary Mr. Tilghman and the Receiver General Mr. Physick it was the opinion of the Board the whole should be returned on the Warrant to Peter Diel (as appears by a Copy of the ~~the~~ minutes of the said Hearing the 30 of March 1773) The Warrant to Peter Diel bears Date the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1755
