



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate ob ob Wellam Township York County containing four Acres and ob hundred and thirty Perches and an Allowance proportion ob Six acres 90 Cent for Roads and Highways being part of ob Tract of one hundred Acres which was Surveyed the thir ob day of April 1749 and returned to the Surveyor General's of ob April 1752 by M<sup>r</sup> Cookson for Philip Pence as appea ob rough Draught thereof in my Possession

Philip Pence sold and conveyed the whole Tract to Adam Fishburn, and Adam Fishburn sold this part to George Schaller for whom it was Surveyed and divided from the whole Tract the 27<sup>th</sup> day of December 1752. / p Geo Stevenson D.S.
