



A Draft of a Tract of land situated on Ewit's Creek in Cumberland Valley Township Bedford County containing Eleven Hundred and eight acres and fifty five perches and allowance of six percent for roads &c. surveyed for Thomas Barnsley the 9th day of June 1766 on Warrant dated the 1st day of June 1763.

No. 1 Represented by dotted lines is a part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for John Blair on Warrant dated the 29th day of July 1823 - this tract interferes Twenty nine acres and Ninety six perches with the Thomas Barnsley survey - John Blair is the present owner -

No. 2 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Samuel Payton on Warrant dated the 29th day of February 1788 - this tract interferes Seventy five and one half acres with the Thomas Barnsley survey. Samuel Payton conveyed to David Kuffman & Thomas Leazure. David Kuffman conveyed his part to Frederick Simons the present owner. Thomas Leazure conveyed to William Leazure the present owner.

No. 3 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Amos Dickens on Warrant dated the 16th day of May 1793 - this tract interferes twenty nine acres and forty two perches with Thomas Barnsley survey - Amos Dickens conveyed to Thomas Dickens whose heirs and heirs now own the land.

No. 4 is part of a Draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Stephen & Amos Dickens on Warrant dated the 11th day of May 1786 - this tract interferes forty seven acres and thirty perches with the Thomas Barnsley survey - Stephen & Amos Dickens conveyed to Thomas Dickens whose heirs and heirs now own the land.
