



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Saucon Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania, Containing Thirty one acres and 3 1/4 Perches of Land, together with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, which formerly <sup>was</sup> Surveyed for Henry Alshouse or to Jacob Weaver, by virtue of a Warrant granted by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries to the said Henry Alshouse Dated on the 11<sup>th</sup> October Anno. 1750, who had assigned his Right to the said Jacob Weaver and at last the Right to the same was sold and assigned to the present Possessor Adam Kwitz, Resurveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> November Anno. 1757 and now Drawn for the said Adam Kwitz, on the 26<sup>th</sup> April Anno. 1782. By Order of the Surveyor General dated the 10<sup>th</sup> April Anno. 1782.
