Located on the 15th day of June 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Steel for 50^a dated the 1st day of October 1741 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report The above Land is entirely embraced in a Large Survey of 355^a 469 perches & the usual allowance made on the 27th day of March 1768 on an order of the Board of Property dated the 1st of July 1767. The whole is owned & occupied by Peter Williamson. The Dotted Lines represent the residue of the Large Survey
