



Pursuant to Sundry Warrants & Applications, Surveyed on the 8th & 9th Decem^r 1784 to John Yoder the three above Described Tracts of Land, Situated in Bern Township Bern's County & Distinguished as follows viz -

- The Tract Mark'd A on a Warrant Dated 24th Novem^r 1784 to John Yoder containing one hundred & seventy eight acres & 135 perches
- The Tract Mark'd B on a Warrant to John Yoder Dated the 14th Aug^r 1750, containing Seventy ^{Six} acres & 110 perches } A-53-295 & allowance
- The Tract Mark'd C on an Application N^o 197th Dated Oct^r 1st 1766, containing Five Acres, 75 Perches } D-53-171

N.B. the Tract A is chiefly very poor Land, full of Ground ob^r. the Tract B chiefly cleared. - Of the Tract D. I have only to Remark that in the course of my Surveying the others when I happened to Go on the Line - the Variation of my Needle from the courses expressed in the Draught (which now passes this) Was uniformly Four Degrees
