



Situate now in Hamilton town township Adams County formerly a part of York County all in the State of Penn. and when first located by John Cunningham then Dept. for John Armstrong who was then Deputy Surveyor for the District composed of Cumberland County 11th Sept. 1767 in pursuance of an Order of Survey to John Davis No 3416 Dated April the 11th 1767 but upon its interfering with the Right of John Potter & Robt Levers at that time held by John Baker & Jacob Baker, that part of the Location of the John Davis Location No 3416 Dated 11th Apr. 1867. Located 11th Sept. 1767 became Null and void and is now is on the Ground for ever afterwards. As Abraham D. Ditmars owning a part thereof applied to me by the way of Process to Survey his part thereof in order to obtain a patent for it; when I made a full investigation of his Claim of title papers. I then found out by them that a Return on the original Survey Made 11th Sept. 1767 by John Cunningham then Dept. for John Armstrong D.S. of Cumberland Co.
