

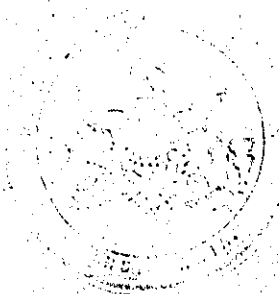
A Draught of sundry Surveys made for Thomas Wallis on several Parcels of Land situate on the Branches of Octoraro Creek in Oxford (formerly London) Township in the County of Chester

- A. N. Described 135^{ac} his first survey formerly Return'd on two Warrants both bearing Date the 7th of December 1747.*
 - D. The second Survey 22 1/2^{ac} formerly Return'd in Pursuance of another Warrant of the same Date with the above mentioned.*
 - E. The third Survey 6 1/4^{ac} In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date Novem. 30th 1751.*
 - B. C. the fourth Survey 33 1/2^{ac} In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the same Day of the last mentioned.*
 - F. the fifth Survey 5 1/2^{ac} & the allowance as usual In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 15th August 1755.*
 - G. A Vacant tract Remain'd survey'd for his Son John Wallis who had Improvements thereon & requested the same might be added as there were so many warrants.*
- The whole Survey'd & described in one Draught at the Owner's Request
