



In pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August Anno 1707 for Surveying to Clement Plumsted and Sarah Wall one thousand acres of Land in this Province in Right of their father William Plumsted's Grant from the Proprietor for that Quantity this may Certifie that on the fourth day of April 1711 five hundred acres in part thereof was Surveyed to the said Clement and Sarah on the North East Branch of Brandywine Creek in the County of Chester bounded as in the above Draught Which said quantity of 500 acres is now ~~is~~ in the Possession of David Powell conveyed to him by Lease & Release dated the 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> days of August Anno 1723
