Co. town township Cumberland County containing four Hundred & forty seven acres & sixty five Perches & allon<sup>m</sup> of six percent for Roads &c: which appears to have been surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> October 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant from the late Proprietors to Rob<sup>t</sup> Levers bearing Date the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1750. The original of which has been Delivered over to me by my Predecessor Sam<sup>l</sup> Lyon Esq. as an Office Paper. The Survey must have been Executed Under the Direction of Sam<sup>l</sup> Lyon who was the Deputy Surveyor of the District at the Date of the Survey. — Certif<sup>d</sup> June 15<sup>th</sup> 1801. —
