Resurveyed in pursuance of an order from the Board of Property, <sup>dated October 16<sup>th</sup> 1809</sup> granted on petition of John Brown, Situate in Allegheny County on the head waters of Turtle Creek & Plum Creek containing Three hundred & one Acres and forty three perches and Allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c

I divided the Tracts agreeable to the orders and not to the improvement viz. I laid Wm. Menoch's Warrant on the waters it specifies and gave him Land in proportion to his Warrant <sup>which calls for 200 acres</sup> &c
