On the above Plot or Draught I laid down the interferences exactly as Hoffmans survey interferes with the Marrow
 line of Kind Creek Marrow, and as the Return in the S. Gen^l Office of Hoffmans survey was made. The improvement
 on the remaining part for Hoffmans warrant is very old, but I cannot ascertain how old. The small tract marked A is
 covered by an older survey on Jacob Neoffs right.
