We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that James Clemens is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio - on the waters of Buffaloe Creek to include his actual Settlement made in the year of Our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy four.

Given under our hands at Red Stone old fort the Eleventh Day of December 1779 - in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
