



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on Broad Top, or Walnut Top, on the Waters of Raysstown Branch of Juniata in the County of Bedford, Containing One thousand and seven Acres & 154 p<sup>s</sup> with the usual allowance of six p<sup>s</sup> Cent for Roads &c Resurveyed June the 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> 1791 on a Warrant dated August 15<sup>th</sup> 1766 granted to John Reed, for 3350 Acres of Land being the remainder of the Original Purchase of Francis Smith - agreeably to the Order of the Board of Property Dated October 15<sup>th</sup> 1790.
