



Situate formerly in Shrewsbury but now Hopewell Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 215^{ac} & 68 perches and allowance, being part of a larger Tract of 397^{ac} & 113 perches & allow^{ce} which was Originally Surveyed on the 14th of the 3rd mo. 1766 by William Matthews late D.S. for Thomas Curry. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} dated 15th of July 1762. Including three other Surveys belonging to said Curry, 2^d made by John Churchman on 2 Warrants one for 25^{ac} dated February 7th 1748. the other for 50^{ac} dated 3rd of August 1749 The other by Thomas Armor on a Warrant for 50^{ac} dated the 28th of May 1750. And afterwards to wit on the 12th day of the 12th mo. 1794 Resurveyed and divided off the above from the said larger Tract of Land by Joseph Kersey D.S. under William Kersey late D.S. and now at the request of the present owner John Collins, I am desired to make Return of the Draught, as calculated, examined and Corrected the 9th day of August A.D. 1809.
