



Agreeably to an Order of the Board of Property Dated the 6th day of April 1795. Jacob Drutt & John Wiltner met me on the Ground on the 13th day of September 1796. And before I proceeded to Execute the said Order agreeably to the Tenor thereof the above named parties agreed that I should Lay off Three Acres off of Wiltners part (Called in said Order 330^a) to Jacob Drutts part which I accordingly did then there Remains 325 1/2 Acres ^{4 allomance} for Wiltner in Pursuance of Alexander Hendersons Warrant Dated the 9th day of April 1776. as is above described Situate in Windsor Township York County. Both satisfied
