



A Draught of Two pieces of lands situation Nopewell & Shrewsbury Townships in the County of York. The piece where the letter A is placed Contains 95.36 perches and was first surveyed on the Warrant of John McCall; But afterwards (the Warrant not being filled) there was an Action between John McCall and Andrew Finley ordering the part where the letter B stands to be surveyed to the said Warrant of John McCall containing 157.4 acres & 94. perches. I Examined the Titles of the Present Owner when I made the survey & Find they Express Both the above pieces and also the order of The Board of Property Resurveyed by the lines formerly run the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1797. In Pursuance of a Warrant to John McCall Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1754 Containing Separate as is above set forth
