



Situate in Shrewsbury Township York County That piece called Sultzdale was surveyed about 28 years ago by order of Tho^o. Cookson In Pursuance of a Warrant for 25^a dated the 2^d of September 1745 now resurveyed for Philip Low In Pursuance of the same Warrant the 20th of the 5th mo. 1775 The small addition at N with about 1.9^a more was added to the survey by Thomas Anmor in the year 1754. That called Repsocker surveyed for him the 1st of the 6th mo 1775 In Pursuance of a Warrant for 30^a dated the 18th of December 1751. That called Trout Runca surveyed for him the same day In pursuance of two Warrants, one for 40^a dated the 9th of October 1750 the other for 50^a dated the 4th of April 1751. And that called Stainborough the 29th of the 5th mo. 1775 for him In Pursuance of a Warrant for 60^a dated the 10th day of April 1750.
