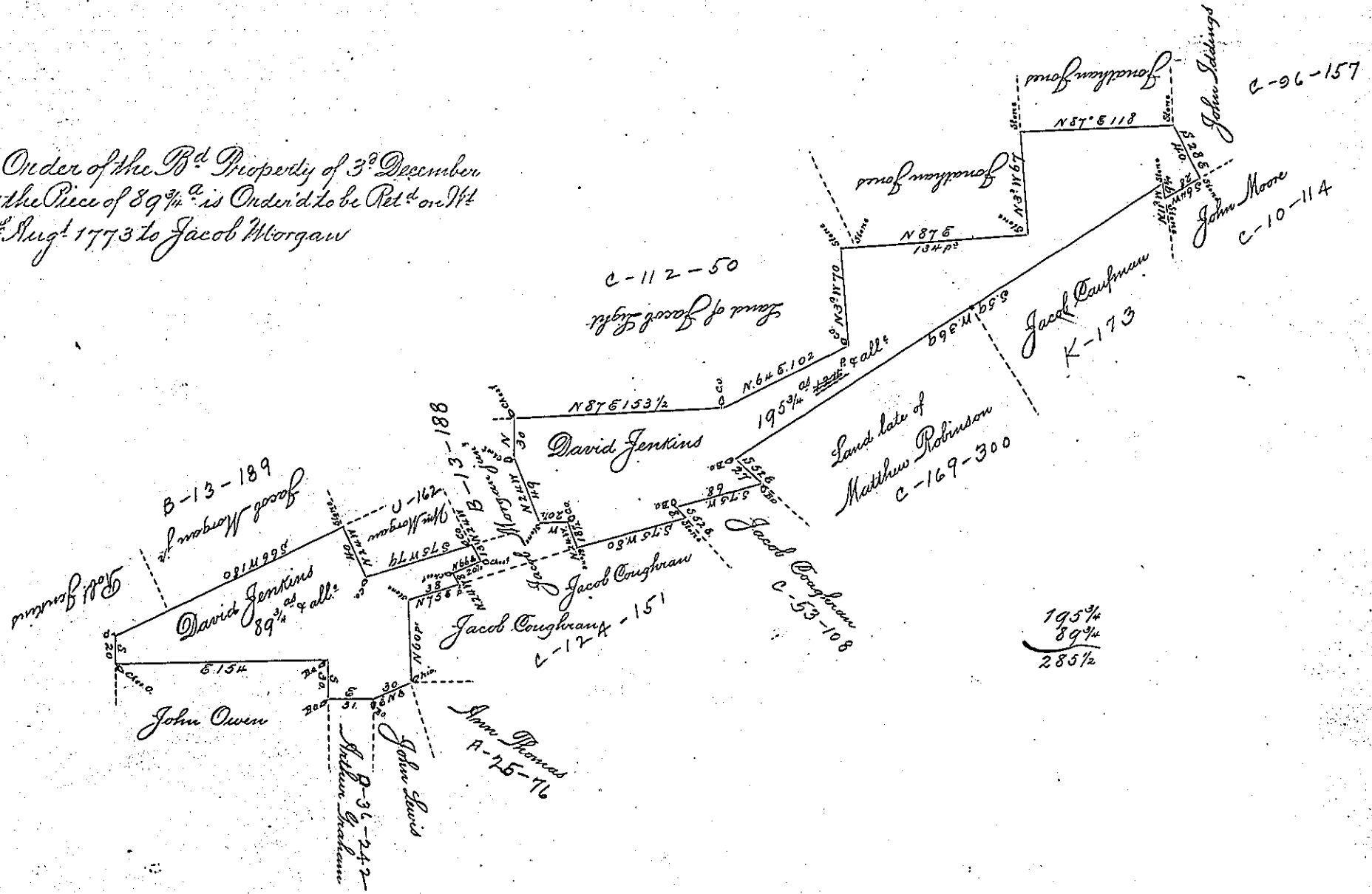


By Order of the Bd Property of 3<sup>d</sup> December 1787 the Piece of 89<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ac is Ordered to be Ret<sup>d</sup> on 11<sup>th</sup> of 16<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>t</sup> 1773 to Jacob Morgan



By Virtue of a Warrant bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Dom<sup>i</sup> 1773 the above described two Tracts of Land were surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> mo of the same year for David Jenkins situate on the Welsh Mountain part thereof being in the Township of Carnarwan in Berks & Lancaster Counties & part in West Mantruel Township in Chester County One containing 195<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ac & the other 89<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ac & the Allowance of Six p<sup>ts</sup> Cent
