



Surveyed, the above described tract of land, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1841, for Alexander Hamilton and William Quigley, by virtue of their Order of resurvey, bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1834, granted on their warrant for 400 acres, dated July 22<sup>d</sup> 1822. Containing four hundred acres, and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. - Situation on the waters of Kettle Creek, about eight miles from its mouth in Chapman Township in the County of Clinton, and bounded as above described
