



Draft of three adjoining tracts of land: situate in Windsor township, Berks County, containing in the whole One hundred and thirty five acres, twenty six perches & allowance of 6 p. & all. Surveyed to George Nower, in pursuance of three Warrants granted to him, to wit:

- A. containing 42^{ac} 118 p. & all
 - B. do. 58^{ac} 12 p. & all
 - C. containing 34^{ac} 65 p. & all
- on two Warr^{ts} dated respectively April 14th 1750.
 on Warrant dated the 25th May A.D. 1773.

As appears from a General Draft of James Seull, remaining filed in the Deputy Surveyors Office of Berks County, October 8th 1827.

It appears that one of the above Warrants of 14th April 1750 has already been patented - the land not included in the above diagram, and as the applicant for the present patents has no regular chain of title from Nower reciting the two Warrants, but makes proof of a long uninterrupted possession, - the Board direct the two Lots A. & B. to be accepted on the remaining warrant of Nower.
