



Situate in Chanceford township York County the piece marked A surveyed and returned p^r John Churchman for David M^cCanley on warrant dated the 19th of June 1745 the piece marked B surveyed p^r George Stevenson for the same on warrant of the 19th of May 1752 but said not returned the piece marked C I surveyed on warrant to John M^canolly (the ^{present} owner of the whole) dated the 29th day of July 1772 which piece contains 24^{ac} & all the other two tracts contain together 301^{3/4} & all.

The whole Resurveyed the 28th day of the 11th mo. 1772.
