I hereby Certify That from the Testimony of James Russell a person of Character it appears that there was a small Improvement on the Lands above described in Manallan Township - ~~Franklin~~ in the Year 1757. But on the South side of Conewago Creek in Cumberland (now Franklin Township) there was no Improvement until after the date of John Grates Warrant
