In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Comiss^{rs} of Sp^{ty} dated the 27th day of August last past. There was Survey'd to Stephen Atkinson of the County of Chester. Clother, two pieces or peels of Land in the 5th County of Chester. One of which 5th parcels is a Certain Neck of Land situate between the Tract Survey'd to Jacob Loudus & Woodrick Howers & Conestogoe Creek. Beginning at a White Oak Standing by the 5th Conestogoe Creek being a corner of the 5th Jacob Loudus & Woodrick Howers Land thence East by North by the same Land 68 pches to a poplar Tree thence North by West by Land Survey'd for William Hughes 29 pches to a Black Oak Standing by the 5th Conestogoe Creek thence down the same on the several courses thereof 640 pches to the place of Beginning Containing One hundred & thirty eight acres.
