N.B. The Lake covered lines are part of a Draft of a tract of Land Surveyed for Samuel Waltman on Warrant dated the 28th day of September 1792. this tract Interferes one hundred and Eighteen Acres and allowance of six per cent with the John Cessna Tract. John Cessna conveyed to Samuel Waltman who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and then conveyed to William Poor the present owner
