Dated July 13th 1767, which mistake in the Calculation, had not been discovered until after he had obtained a patent for the same; And the above Named Adam Turner's Application, ^{taken for the same Land} being miscarried, did not come into my hands until above Four Years after that I had returned the said Tract under the said William Nanna's Right.
