The Black lines represent a draft of a tract of land situate on the Raystown Branch of Juniatta In Napier township Bedford County, containing Ninety five Acres & one hundred & fifteen perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads - Surveyed for John Dixon on order N^o 617, dated the 1st day of August 1766.

N^o 1 represented by the lake bordered lines, is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Solomon Adams in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 14th day of June 1785 - this tract Interferes Forty three Acres & fifty three perches with the John Dixon tract.

N^o 2 represented by the dotted lines, is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Solomon Adams in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 13th day of September 1794 - this tract interferes fifty two acres & sixty two perches with the John Dixon tract. Solomon Adams conveyed both of said tracts to John Mowrey - who conveyed the same to Frederick Byers, who conveyed the same to George Mullin Esqr the present owner
