Granted to Jacob Wolfington by Virtue of three Warrants bearing Dates 11th of October 1738-1st of March 1749 & 24th day of October 1750- The black lines describes a part of the above tract containing one hundred and twenty three acres forty two perches & allowance of 6 p^{ts} Cent & surveyed for Nezekiah Freestone the 18th Day of March A.D. 1822
