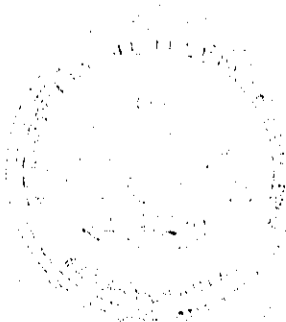

Containing three quarters of an Acre or thereabouts, surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant, dated the 4th Day of November Anno Domini one thousand Eight hundred and seven, Granted to Terrah Jones - November 5th 1807.
